

**Illinois Data on Immigrant Population in Counties,
Places, and Metro Areas
From the American Community Survey 2006**

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The Illinois Department of Human Services, Refugee and Immigrant Citizenship Initiative

Overview

- This report presents data from the 2006 American Community Survey conducted by the US Census Bureau.
- While selected geographies were emphasized for the state of Illinois, data sets also varied in the amount of information we were able to obtain. We present all of the available data for the region.
- Some highlights for the state include:
 - In 2006, the number of Latinos residing in Illinois reached 1,888,439 making them the second largest racial/ethnic group in the state.
 - Congressional District 4 (Gutierrez – D) has the largest Latino population in the state.
 - Illinois has over 1.7 million foreign-born residents, which is nearly 14%
 - 9.8% of people living in the state are limited-English speakers.
 - In Illinois there are 724,845 foreign-born residents whose region of origin is Mexico. 438,646 residents have immigrated from Asia and 420,704 have immigrated from Europe.
