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## Immigration and Growth

This report identifies growth in the number of foreign-born persons (“immigrants”) in Illinois between 2000 and 2006.<sup>1</sup> The 2010 Census will lead to the creation of new boundaries for Illinois Senate and House Districts. Immigration is responsible for the majority of population growth in Illinois. This report highlights the role of immigration in population change in Illinois, and identifies shifts in the numbers of native-born persons and naturalized immigrants.

Data on the populations of state senate and house districts are available from the U.S. Census Bureau. We developed updated estimates for the year 2006 by employing an allocation model to new population data recently issued by the Bureau. A methodology section at the end of this report describes this procedure in more detail.

## Findings

### State of Illinois

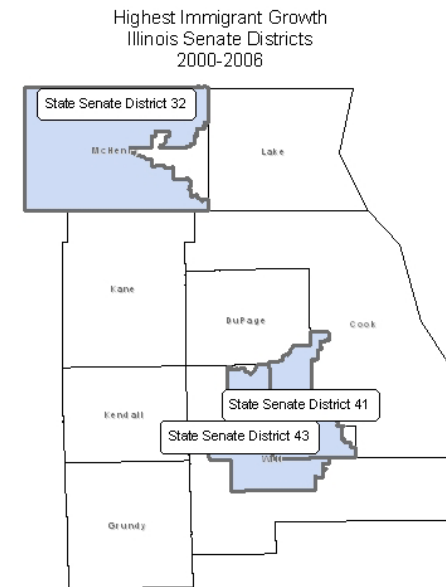
- Immigration provides the great majority of Illinois population growth.
  - Overall population grew by 3% between 2000 and 2006 -- this was 363,756 persons
  - Native-born population grew by 1% -- this contributed 39% of the overall population growth
  - Immigrant population grew by 14% -- this contributed 61% of the overall population growth
  - Citizen-immigrant population (naturalized immigrants) grew by 27% -- this contributed 45% of the overall population growth

## State Senate

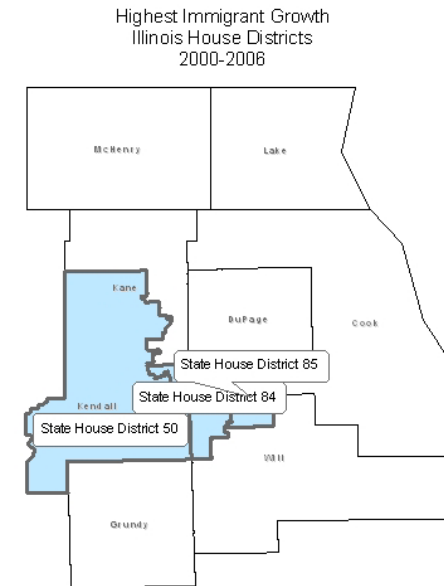
- Top three districts with the highest overall population growth rate:
  - Senate District 43 (A.J. Wilhelmi – D) at 33% -- immigrants contributed 26% and citizen-immigrants 11% of this growth
  - Senate District 32 (Pamela J. Althoff – R) at 27% -- immigrants contributed 24% and citizen immigrants 12% of this growth
  - Senate District 25 (Chris Lauzen – R) at 25% -- immigrants contributed 18% and citizen immigrants 8% of this growth
- Top three districts with the highest native-born growth rate:
  - Senate District 43 (A.J. Wilhelmi – D) at 27%
  - Senate District 32 (Pamela J. Althoff – R) at 22%
  - Senate District 25 (Chris Lauzen – R) at 22%
- Top three districts with the highest immigrant growth rate:
  - Senate District 32 (Pamela J. Althoff – R) at 84%
  - Senate District 43 (A.J. Wilhelmi – D) at 78%
  - Senate District 41 (Christine Radogno - R) at 75%
- Top three districts with the highest citizen immigrant growth rate were:
  - Senate District 32 (Pamela J. Althoff – R) at 84%
  - Senate District 43 (A.J. Wilhelmi – D) at 78%
  - Senate District 41 (Christine Radogno - R) at 75%



## State House

- Top three districts with the highest overall population growth rate:
  - House District 85 (Emily McAsey – D) at 52% -- immigrants contributed 23% and citizen immigrants 12% of this growth
  - House District 84 (Tom Cross - R) at 36% -- immigrants contributed 29% and citizen immigrants 11% of this growth
  - House District 50 (Kay Hatcher - R) at 31% -- immigrants contributed 15% and citizen immigrants 6% of this growth

- Top three districts with the highest native-born growth rate:
  - House District 85 (Emily McAsey – D) at 45%
  - House District 50 (Kay Hatcher - R) at 27%
  - House District 84 (Tom Cross - R) at 26%
- Top three districts with the highest immigrant growth rate:
  - House District 84 (Tom Cross - R) at 193%
  - House District 85 (Emily McAsey – D) at 119%
  - House District 50 (Renée Kosel - R) at 117%
- Top three districts with the highest citizen-immigrant growth rate:
  - House District 85 (Emily McAsey – D) at 163%
  - House District 84 (Tom Cross - R) at 142%
  - House District 18 (Julie Hamos - D) at 139%



Other Illinois Geographic Regions

- City of Chicago had a 5% decline in its overall population -- native-born declined by 6% and immigrants declined by 4%
- Suburban Cook County had 3% growth in its overall population growth – native-born declined by 0.2% and immigrants grew by 16%
- Seven collar counties had 15% growth in its overall population – native-born grew by 11% and immigrants grew by 42%
- 94 downstate counties had 1% growth in its overall population – native-born grew by 0.3% and immigrants grew by 25%

Observations

Some interesting observations on population growth for the period 2000 to 2006 are below:

The State as a whole:

- Overall population growth in Illinois of 3% is less than the national average of 6% -- this placed Illinois in the bottom 20 states for overall population growth.

## Senate Districts:

- 31 Senate Districts had declines in their native-born population:<sup>2</sup>
  - Except Senate District 7 (Heather Steans – D) which had a decline in both native-born and immigrants, each of these 31 Senate Districts had growth in their immigrant population
  - Of these 31 Senate Districts, seven had growth in their overall population due to growth in immigrants compensating for the declines in native-born<sup>3</sup>
- Six Senate Districts had declines in their immigrant population:<sup>4</sup>
  - Except Senate District 7 (Heather Steans – D) which as noted earlier had a decline in both native-born and immigrants, each of these six Senate Districts had growth in their native-born population
  - Of these six Senate Districts, only Senate District 12 (Martin Sandoval – D) had growth in overall population due to the growth in native-born compensating for the declines in immigrants

## House Districts:

- 63 House Districts had declines in their native-born population:<sup>5</sup>
  - Except for nine House Districts,<sup>6</sup> each of these 63 House Districts had growth in their immigrant population
  - Of these 63 House Districts, 20 had growth in overall population due to growth in immigrants compensating for declines in native-born<sup>7</sup>
- 18 House Districts had declines in immigrant population:<sup>8</sup>
  - Ten of these 18 House Districts had growth in their native-born population<sup>9</sup>

- Of these 10 House Districts that had growth in their native-born population, only five had growth in overall population -- these five had sufficient growth in native-born to compensate the decline in immigrants

Illinois geographic regions:

- City of Chicago, Suburban Cook County, Cook County and DuPage County lost native-born population
- Suburban Cook County and DuPage County managed overall population growth due to the growth in immigrants compensating the decline in native-born -- immigrants in Suburban Cook County and DuPage County grew by 16% and 25%, respectively

The subsequent sections of this report provide data tables on immigrant growth by State legislative districts and geographic regions. In examining this data, please note the following:

- If “n/a” is used, then the relevant population group did not grow over the period 2000 to 2006
- If “n/a\*” is used, then overall population did not grow over the period 2000 to 2006
- High shares may result when the overall population grows by a very small number and the relevant group has grown by a significantly larger number

This is from decennial census for 2000 of the U.S. Census Bureau. This was provided by the U.S. Census Bureau in summary format for the State legislative districts and Illinois geographic regions analyzed in this report.

### *Data for Year 2006:*

To improve the reliability of data estimates and reduce sampling variability, we aggregated three years of data, 2005-2007, from the American Community Survey (“ACS”). The ACS is conducted by the US Census Bureau and data from 1% of households are provided for analysis. Given the we aggregated three calendar years of data, our data represents a sample of 3% of the population and may be described as representing year 2006.

To obtain data for State legislative districts, we used ACS data at the Public Use Microdata (PUMA) level for Illinois. We assigned data from the PUMAs into state legislative districts using a geographic equivalency file that informed us of which blocks in each PUMA are found within each legislative district. We used block-level data on race/ethnicity from the 2000 census to assign the 2005-2007 PUMA variables into legislative districts.

To obtain data for various Illinois geographic area such as cities and counties, we used ACS data at the PUMA level for Illinois. We aggregated PUMAs into the relevant geographic areas.
